2023 FINAL PROGRESS REPORT

2023 Board Milestones and Goals

- 1. Increase DCBC membership to at least 100 registrations by December 1 2023 (127 Registrations)
- 2. Participate in the Brian Smith ride with members fully kitted in DCBC jerseys (Did it and presented check for \$1000!)
- 3. Public Check Donations (Mountain Flyers, Little Bellas, Hank Poore Foundation)
- 4. Host DCBC Gravel Rides Thanks to Paul McCracken, Danny Stamps, and David Williams!
- 5. Pass Bylaw Revisions to modernize job responsibilities and titles (Done!)
- 6. Post a weekly ride and events schedule (Much better than before).
- 7. Relocate DCBC trailer (@ Munny Sokol Park, stored for free)
- 8. Increase months with social activities (Monthly PLP, July 4th Ride, SS45MC, Put Me In Coach, etc.)
- 9. Obtain 400 Hot Hundred Registrations (325 Registrations)
- 10. Hot Hundred increase profit over prior years, decrease financial burden on club \$6,000 profit for DCBC this year,
- 11. Clarify club insurance Instituted waiver forms for non-members; investigating other insurance options
- 12. Relocate club ride starting location to River District Park for safety and convenience
- 13. Reclaim Instagram account; condensed all DCBC Strava clubs to one; condensed all DCBC Facebook clubs; There is a second DCBC Facebook page out there. Tried to close it down.
- 14. Establish DCBC Daytime Riders Group thanks to Jim Cockrell! Expand membership in this.
- 15. Recognize weekly top 20 riders for distance, speed, climbing, etc. Did not have this in Nov. and Dec.
- 16. Survey members four times this year about club progress. Three surveys completed.
- 17. Host four Sanders Ferry Cleanups Three clean up sessions completed. One in April and two in July.
- 18. Hire and recognize Hot Hundred Director
- 19. Move Hot Hundred Start/Finish Use Bryce Campus Drive for start, add HH banner, add music upgrade social/food/drink at start, add vendors to HH start
- 20. Add an ultra route to the Hot Hundred
- 21. Advertise in four states about the Hot Hundred, put up posters in bike shops!
- 22. Sell Club Jerseys throughout the year
- 23. Increase DCBC swag koozies to club members, club decals, hat orders, t-shirts (didn't get to do it).
- 24. End financial year with a positive balance over prior year
- 25. Increase Gobble Cross Sponsorships and Participation over prior year.
- 26. Recognize a "Rider of the Month" beginning in March through the end of the riding season. Then award a "Rider of the Year" at the Christmas Party.
- 27. Bring back the Sanders Ferry Time Trials! Need greater attendance!
- 28. Recognize outgoing and returning officers!
- 29. Increase number of drawings and giveaways year round and at Christmas party.
- 30. Use the Past-Presidents Group as an advisory council. Tap into them as much as possible.
